## MERRIMACK AGRICULTURAL COMMISSION MINUTES September 10, 2014

In the absence of Bob McCabe, Cindy Warhola chaired the meeting. Opened the meeting at 7:09 p.m.

**New Business** 

- (a) Farmer's Market update: Tom Hanlon managed the Markets on Sept. 3 and Sept. 10, 2014. \$60.00 was appropriated for a new sign for the Farmer's Market. We received an invitation to join in the Business Expo at Watson Park on Sept. 27, 2014.
- (b) **Community Garden update**: Bob McCabe had asked the gardeners who were not picking all of their crops if we could pick them and donate them to a soup kitchen. No response was received.
- (c) **Education**: There are meetings to benefit gardeners being held. One on seed saving at Shaker Village, one on preserving in Hookset. You can go onto extension.unh.edu to find a more complete list.
- (d) Bug alert: Alan Eaton, entomologist, says Eastern Ash Borer (EAB) is still not too high in N.H.
- (e) **Treasurer's report**: Bess said total for the Farmer's Market was \$2,348.37 and the Community Garden was \$2,109.26, making a total of \$4457.26 as of August 31, 2014.
- (f) Minutes of August 13, 2014 were read and accepted with a couple of corrections. Bess moved to accept and Eber seconded. Vote was 4-0-0.

Comments from the Commissioners: Eber spoke about the complaints about rooster crowing on Baboosic Lake Road. It will be on the Town Council's agenda on Thursday, September 11, 2014.
