HHNP Meeting Minutes

February 25, 2019

- 1. 6:30 PM Meeting was called to order by Bruce P.
- 2. Cindy G. Of MCC reports that Loop Trail, between posts 3 & 4 will remain closed until further notice by MCC. The MCC is scheduled to meet on March 4, 2019 and will discuss the re-opening of the trail at the suggestion of the HHNP sub-committee.
- 3. Bruce P. requests of MCC that procedures be provided to the HHNP sub-committee for guidance on the steps involved to determine if a trail should be closed, and to notify the public of the action.
- 4. Discussion about the availability of proper signage to be placed regarding a closed trail. What should the signs say? Does the town have sandwich boards that the HHNP would be permitted to use for this purpose?
- 5. Discussion about process of a review to close a trail. Suggestion to call a "special meeting" of a quorum of the HHNP sub committee to access the area to determine if an area should be closed.
- 6. Bruce P. suggests that the HHNP sub-committee develop goals that will provide improvements, improve safety, more effectively communicate with the public and provide educational benefit.
 - a. In a motion brought by Bruce P. and seconded by Tim A. there is a need to re-work the main trail from the Amherst St parking lot to post 3 to reduce/re-direct run-off to allow the trail to remain open year-round.
 - b. Education. Tim A. has offered to plan a hike in late May to look at wild flowers. He also suggested looking out over Long Pond for Herron and osprey in late June.
- 7. Meeting minutes of February 4, 2019 were approved as amended.
- 8. Final comment. Don L. asks if the MCC would like the HHNP sub-committee to prepare a presentation for their July 2019 meeting? Additionally, Don L. would like to volunteer if the MCC wants to start a beaver committee.
