**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Two residents discussed some recent issues with Hunters/hunting in the trails as well as concern with two wooden and one metal tree stand that are close to the trails.

One issue with hunters firing /hunting within 200-250 feet (Measured) from homes on Beebe lane (law is 300 feet). Other issue is that some hunters observed using the cul-de-sac as a bathroom.

Suggestion for safety /noise is to see if the town could suggest/ordinance change to make the no shoot within x feet of homes from 300 to 600 feet.

Also suggest that hunters be recommended to not hunt from nor shoot across the trails.
