The following is an overview of the activities performed by Equipment Maintenance and Highway Divisions in the Merrimack Public Works Department in April 2014:

Equipment Maintenance Division

- Completed 50 corrective maintenance repair orders and road service calls on Town vehicles, including:
 - Mounted service body on Equipment Maintenance truck M-1
 - Completed fabrication of tank and rack for Fire Department forestry truck F-3
 - Repaired exhaust manifold for Highway pickup truck H-4
- Performed 71 preventive maintenance repair orders
- Performed 14 state inspections
- Issued 5 repair orders to outside entities, including:
 - Replaced ten tires for Fire forestry vehicle F-3
 - Replaced front spring assembly for Highway dump truck H-21
 - Replaced turbo, oil seals & gasket for Solid Waste tractor L-6



• Managed \$17,416 in equipment maintenance town-wide








Highway and Parks Maintenance Division

- Received or managed 149 work orders and service requests
 - Closed 105 work orders
 - 66% were open for less than 30 days
 - 71% of pothole requests were closed in less than 72 hours from first report



- Removed plows and spreaders from Highway vehicles
- Continued annual catch basin cleaning program
- Commenced annual street sweeping program
- Commenced seasonal gravel road maintenance
- Provided assistance with town elections
- Corrected blocked drainage causing property flooding on Woodbury Street
- Restored seasonal water service at Wasserman Park and athletic fields
- Repaired and placed picnic tables at various parks
- Commenced laying out athletic fields, stocked all sheds with chalk and paint
- Responded to beaver activity in several areas
- Assisted with S.A.D.D. mock DUI demonstration on O'Gara Drive
- Removed trees and low-hanging branches in various locations
