The following is an overview of the activities performed by Equipment Maintenance and Highway divisions in the Merrimack Public Works Department in June 2013:

Equipment Maintenance Division


- Completed 95 corrective maintenance repair orders and road service calls on Town vehicles, including:
 - o Replaced full set of tires for Fire Department utility truck, U-1
 - Replaced oil cooler for Highway loader H-16
 - o Replaced frame and cylinders for the plow on 1-ton dump truck H-9
 - Performed troubleshooting and repairs to boom mower, sweeping broom, electrical system, and replaced alternator for utility vehicle H-43
 - Received towing for breakdown, and replaced fuel pump and system on dump truck H-27
- Performed 50 preventive maintenance repair orders
- Performed 1 state inspection



• Managed \$15,355 in equipment maintenance Town-wide








Highway and Parks Maintenance Division

June highlights:

- Received and managed <u>158</u> work orders and service requests
 - Closed 129 work orders in June
 - 77% of WO opened in June were closed in June
 - 43% of pothole requests were closed within 72 hours



- Brought several discarded or damaged utility poles to Milford wood processing plant
- Received bids for replacement backhoe loader H-13 and upfit of replacement 6wheel dump truck H-23
- Flushed the obstructed cross culvert on Naticook Road at Greens Pond Road with the assistance of Wastewater Division, and installed beaver control device at inlet
- Mowed and trimmed the Town-owned property at 19 Cabot Road
- Performed drainage maintenance or repairs at the following locations:
 - Burt/Dover Street
 - Carriage Lane
 - Naticook Road
 - Beacon Drive
 - Shore Drive
 - Greatstone Drive
 - Pebble Court

- o Planned for reconfiguration of Patten Rd intersection with Baboosic Lake Road
- o Planned for drainage master plan work on Bedford Road and Beech Street
- o Planned for 4th of July parade and midway assistance
- Delivered large boulder to Brooks Monuments for installation of Seaverns Bridge historical placard
- Corrected fire sprinkler system inspection deficiencies at the highway garage
- Corrected fuel control system inspection deficiencies
- o Completed mowing the landfill and ATV park with utility tractor
- o Surveyed and trimmed tree branches impacting streets to be paved this season
- Assisted Rotary with final placement and installation of all trail signs and posts at Twin Bridge Park to complete the project
- Continued annual street sweeping contract and sidewalk sweeping by Highway Division staff
- o Commenced overhaul of infield at Veteran's Park baseball field #1, placed sod that was removed in the veteran monument and flagpole area
- Provided setup assistance for farmer's market each Wednesday
- Assisted P&R staff at Wasserman Park with annual camp opening and installation of walk in cooler and freezers in the function hall
- Assumed mowing responsibilities for Abbie Griffin Park
- Hired George King as seasonal maintainer
