Press Release - TOWN OF MERRIMACK TAX RATE SET

(November 24, 2021) - The Town of Merrimack's 2021 property tax rate is \$17.17 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. This represents a decrease of \$6.89 per thousand compared to the 2020 rate of \$24.06. A significant portion of the \$6.89 decrease is due to the revaluation that the Town underwent this summer. Without the tax rate decrease caused by the revaluation, the tax rate would have decreased by \$0.21 compared to 2020's rate. The components of the 2020 and 2021 rates are presented below.

To estimate your December amount due:

New Property Value/1,000 X 17.17 - Amt. paid in June/July '21= This represents the amount due for 2021 only

Example: New Property value = \$366,400

June/July Tax Payment = \$3,141

Step 1: 366,400 / 1,000 = 366.4

Step 2: 366.4 X 17.17 = \$6,291 (represents taxes due based on new value and tax rate)

Step 3: \$6,291 – 3,141 = \$3,150 (represents estimated payment due for the December tax bill)
