- Rough outline of dog park area

- Harvesting good portion – forest management program which is about 4 acres
 - Trees need to be marked that are staying one color
 - Trees that need to be harvested marked in another color
 - Mark skid sites in another color
 - About one week to complete
- RFP to be finished by end of April 2014
- Ask Town Council to close park while work is going on and also while park is not being used
- May need a barrier at the end of the parking lot

1 – Town wide master plan for parks and recreational facilities from Chris Christensen

- Need future plans to be included in the current park plans

2 – 2014 Budget from Chris Christensen

- Budget has many similar line items that carry over year over year (heat, phones as example)
- What about the maintenance of the parks?
- “To Do” list to be reviewed
 - Dan Dwyer commented that Wasserman Park will have money put aside
 - Demolish dining hall at Wasserman Park is coming soon
 - Laura Jaynes concerned about Norma French playground – the drop off needs a snow fence
 - Laura Jaynes to talk to the NH Lakes Association to look into grant money for erosion for the waterfront at Wasserman Park
 - Kelly Valluzzi to email Adam about what would be maintenance items that can be performed
 - Function Hall at Wasserman Park could have suggestions to help with acoustics in the room – possible idea would be thicket drapes made of a carpet material to hang like art work
 - Laura Jaynes reviewed all parks with the following items mentioned:
 - Watson Park:
 - Many items regarding signs

- No rope swing
- Need to look into leaving “water quality advisory notice” and “swim at your own risk” notice
- Veteran’s Park:
 - Entrance is well marked
 - Parking lot is one way – designated to be one way but not used that way
 - Any room for parking lot?
 - Laura Jaynes and Kelly Valluzzi to work on press release for kiosk work
- Weston Park:
 - Improvements made from last year
 - Trash is really the issue, which is seasonal
 - Dan Dwyer suggested partnering with Buckley's or someone else to get trash picked up during busy months
