Call Division Openings

The Town of Merrimack is currently accepting applications for positions within the Call Fire/Emergency Medical Services, Training and Safety Division of the Fire Department. All listed positions require minimum of high school diploma and valid driver's license.

The **Call Firefighter** position is an on-call position. Applicants not certified to a minimum of Firefighter I must pass a written exam. All candidates without a current C- PAT certification will need to pass a physical ability test and a physical. For these positions, applicants must be able to respond to calls within an acceptable timeframe to be determined by the Fire Chief. Hourly wage is \$11.70 per hour.

The **Part-Time On-Call Emergency Medical Service (EMS) Attendant** is a position with no predetermined schedule. The current shifts are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. each weekday and weekend. Employees sign up for open shifts that they are available for each month. Other minimum qualifications for this position include Certified National Registered Emergency Medical Technician-Basic or NREMT (EMT-Intermediate/AEMT or Paramedic certification preferred), with the ability to obtain a state of NH EMS Providers License. Hourly wage is \$16.00 per hour. **Application Deadline: 4:00 p.m. on January 26, 2015**
