MERRIMACK, NH: On October 21, 2014, the Merrimack Police Department arrested the above Raymond S. Gillogly on a warrant charging him with aggravated felonious sexual assault and simple assault. The issuance of the warrant stemmed from a reported sexual assault filed with police on the above date at 6:46 p.m.

Specifically, it was alleged that on October 17, 2014, Gillogly and the victim had engaged in an argument and that later that evening, Gillogly attempted to sexually assault the victim by the use of physical force. A struggle took place during which time the victim was able to stop the assault. It was further alleged that when the assault ended, Gillogly spat at the victim.

After further investigation, the above warrant was drafted for Gillogly's arrest and he was taken into custody without incident. Gillogly was subsequently processed on the warrant and posted the above cash bail. Gillogly is scheduled to appear before the Merrimack Circuit Court on October 23, 2014, to answer to the charges

A police canine was called in to the area where a track was picked up which ultimately led to the area of Beech and Cedar Streets, not far from the tower.
