ATTENDANCE: Anita Creager, Lon Wood, Finlay Rothhaus. Ralph Gerenz and Sean Sylvester as potential new members.

REVIEW JUNE MINUTES: Reviewed and accepted. Moved by Finlay and seconded by Lon.

MEMBERSHIP STATUS: Have two full openings and three alternates. **We are in a critical situation.** Both **Ralph and Sean** plan to submit letters of interest to Kristen or Becky this week.

OLD BUSINESS:

Historical Home Plaques: **Lon** has not yet reached Frank Twardosky. **Finlay** has not yet located Matt Trotter. 7 and 20 Fuller Mill, 11 Hadley, 5, 9, 11, 23, 25 and 27 Loop Rd, 8 Harris and 18 Hoyt are approved. Hope to distribute during winter/spring.

John Cromwell plaque replacement: **Lon** will arrange for the plaque/rock to be removed for inspection and determination of repair.

Photos for Memorial Room: **Anita** has emailed Jackie Flood, without response as yet.

Wooden Stocks at Weston Park: No further action planned.

Welcome Signs: Wording will remain as originally voted: "MERRIMACK 1750 FOUR VILLAGES ONE TOWN". **Finlay** will contact Kyle at DPW to see if he can determine the right of way in both locations. **Anita** will contact John Brooks to activate the process. Once signs are made, she will finalize the installation.

K of C Craft fair Nov. 4-5 (Friday and Saturday) We are registered. Will need staff.

Participation in July 4th program booth and event. Successful. Much interest. Distributed many brochures and passports for Scavenger Hunt. Hunt ends Labor Day. **Anita** will removed stations soon after.

Boston Post Cane: Presented to Carsten "Bud" Hahn last week. He was presented with a miniature. **Finlay** will check with Chuck Mower about making more for future use.

Town Tour Brochures: MANY have been distributed. Great deal of interest. Approved the printing as needed. Unanimous vote. Have already printed over 3000.

McGaw Bridge and Bean Road Bridges: 2016 . Bean is open. McGaw anticipated by end of November. **Anita** has photo of original 1915 McGaw sign in Longa possession. Will forward to Finlay and to Kyle. State will be putting a sign on the new bridge.

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NEW BUSINESS:

Town Flag : Sean Sylvester repeated the presentation he gave to the Town Council. Much discussion. This will be a public process to design a Town Flag. **Sean** will take the lead and work with **Finlay** for much of it. He will design a card for distribution listing the requirements for idea submissions. Will investigate possibility of creating at MHS print shop. This will be distributed at all three polls on Nov. 8 election day. **We** will provide staff for this by ourselves, students and possibly Scouts. **Sean** will make a display for those locations. Will advertise through school, library, newspapers. **Sean** will design a webpage. Anticipate including a flyer in the mass mailing from the town in Dec. No date set for completion. Future possibility of flag pole at Town Hall.
