



Full-time Police Officer Town of Merrimack

The Town of Merrimack Police Department is seeking to fill one **Full-time Police Officer** position and create an eligibility list for future Full-time Police Officer openings.

The eligibility process includes, but is not limited to, a written examination, physical agility exam, and an oral board interview. The written exam will be waived for certified applicants, but they will be expected to meet the minimum standards of the physical agility exam and maintain physical fitness standards according to RSA 188-F:27 every three years per NHPSTC. Uncertified applicants will be expected to meet the entry-level requirements for physical fitness held by the NH Police Standards and Training Council.

Candidate(s) moving forward to fill a position would be subject to an interview with the Chief prior to a conditional offer. Post conditional offer, candidates would be required to pass a pre-employment physical and drug test and a thorough background investigation, which includes a polygraph exam.

Minimum Qualifications: High School diploma or GED from an accredited institution. Current full or part-time police officers employed in the State of NH must be certified by the NH Police Standards and Training Council. Candidates not certified must pass the minimum written, oral and physical agility testing.

The current starting hourly wage is \$23.64, with a comprehensive benefits package including participation in the New Hampshire Retirement System.
