TEEN CAMP COUNSELOR:

A Teen Counselor is a special breed of Counselor at Naticook Day Camp. They must be both friend and mentor to a group of campers in a particularly complicated time in life. Despite the innate challenges, the Teen Counselor makes a huge impact in the lives of teenage campers through exciting outdoor activities! The Teen Camp Counselor must have desire to work with children between the ages of 12 and 14. Leadership skills, enthusiasm, patience, a sense of humor, fitness and self-control are all essential. Person must have the ability to provide fun and innovative programs to youth. Applicant must be at least 18 years of age.

SPECIAL NEEDS AIDES:

Special Needs Aides primarily responsible for working in a 1:1 or 1:2 setting with a child who has Special Needs. The goal of the person in this position is helping to integrate the assigned child into the Day Camp Program. Requires the ability to be creative in the integration of assigned camper (s); achieve assigned camper (s) developmental objectives or Summer I.E.P. (Individual Education Program) goals. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.

NATURE ACTIVITY SPECIALIST:

The Nature Activity Specialist is responsible for coordinating and leading environmental activities at Naticook Day Camp. The specialist will develop, plan & lead daily nature activities for groups of children between the ages of 5 – 14. Candidates must be at least 18 years of age and have experience in Nature or Environmental Education.

ASSISTANT WATERFRONT DIRECTOR: WEEKENDS

The Assistant Waterfront Director is responsible for managing the operations of the Waterfront Beach on Naticook Lake on weekends from Late June to Mid August, 2015. Responsibilities including managing weekend Lifeguard staff to ensure proper coverage & operations; assist in training lifeguards their responsibilities in activity during staff training; performs rescue maneuvers, CPR, and First Aid as needed, and takes command during emergency situations. Candidates must be at least 21 years of age and hold current certifications including: CPR/AED for the professional Rescuer; Lifeguard / Waterfront First Aid; Lifeguard Certification from a nationally recognized program.

WATERFRONT LIFEGUARDS - FULL & PART TIME:

Lifeguards are responsible for ensuring the overall safety of the Waterfront environment on Lake Naticook. Lifeguards are also responsible for providing first aid for minor injuries and activating the chain of command for more serious emergencies. Candidates must be at least 16 years of age and possess a current Lifeguard Certification from the American Red Cross, YMCA or other recognized organization; possess a current American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer or American Heart Association Heartsaver certification or comparable; Certification in Standard First Aid. Full & Part Time positions available.

KITCHEN ASSISTANT / PREP COOK:

The Kitchen Assistant assists the Camp Cook in the Operation on their duties. Responsibilities include washing dishes, sweeping & mopping, Taking out trash; cutting, peeling & washing vegetables, as needed. Help unload supply truck and put supplies away. Applicant must be at least 18 years of age and must be able to lift/unload/move food and supplies; Use kitchen equipment safely and operate electrical and mechanical equipment as needed. Applicant must be at least 18 years of age.

PARK MAINTENANCE

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age. Position is responsible for cleaning and maintaining the grounds at Wasserman Park. Position runs from June – August and works 40 hours per week. Certified in CPR & Standard First Aid or willing to obtain.

TENNIS INSTRUCTOR

Applicant must be at least 18 years of age and have experience playing & teaching tennis lessons. Experience working with children preferred. Position runs from June 29th - August 20th (8 weeks) from 8:45 am – 12:00 pm. Certified in CPR & Standard First Aid or willing to obtain.
