

Dear Municipal Officials & Emergency Responders,

Eversource Transmission Operations personnel are planning to perform aerial inspections of the Company's statewide transmission system between Tuesday, 1/19/16 through Friday, 1/22/16. If adverse flying conditions exist, however, this activity will be rescheduled.

We'd appreciate your help notifying residents who own livestock or have commercial enterprises that may need to know about this activity.

PURPOSE OF FLYOVER: The patrols involve a helicopter with an infrared camera that can detect excessive heat on transmission line components. This identifies components that could possibly fail in the future and allows for the scheduling of planned repairs to maintain system reliability.

DATES: Tuesday, 1/19/16 through Friday, 1/22/16, weather permitting

LOCATION: Patrols will take place along power line corridors/rights-of-way between Eversource's substations

DESCRIPTION OF AIRCRAFT: Blue and Yellow Bell Jet Ranger Helicopter, tail # N64JB

FLIGHT TIMES: 7:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
