

Tennessee Gas Pipeline Chronology

Date	Description
April 7, 2014	Received notification of North East Expansion project. Phone calls/email went out to BOC member and district engineers about the information meeting.
April 21, 2014	Information meeting regarding the North East Expansion project at Hollis/Brookline school.
May 6, 2014	Meeting with Steve Martin - Contract Land Agent Northeastern Land Services. Contract land agent to Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company.
August 8, 2014	Update to BOC under "Old Business"
August 15, 2014	Contacted by James Emery asking if the District would join with Hollis to fight the pipeline.
September 12, 2014	Replied to Eileen Cabanel's email asking if we know about the pipeline that would end in Merrimack.
September 15, 2014	Email from Rosemarie Rung thanking us for the information
September 15, 2014	Email from Brandon Kernen from NHDES stating that ENV-DW 302.06 does not allow underground utilities not associated with operating the water source or any other activity within the sanitary radius.
September 15, 2014	Update to BOC under "Old Business" - backup in additional info section
September 16, 2014	Email from Paul Micali - TOM - FYI Tennessee Gas Pipeline pre-files with FERC (Email sent to our engineers can't find any maps) Maps show ending on Northern Boulevard in the area of Webb
September 17, 2014	FYI - Mike Currier (through Carol) still points to Hollis Merrimack
September 23, 2014	FYI - Rosemari Rung - Union Leader articles stating the pipeline would end in Merrimack
October 2, 2014	Email from Keith Pratt - gas pipeline on Salem's website
October 6, 2014	Letter from Tennessee Gas Pipeline stating MVD property no longer affected
October 20, 2014	Update to BOC under "Superintendent's Report" regarding letter stating they are no longer interested
October 28, 2014	Email from Tim Tenhave asking what info we have on the pipeline ending in South Merrimack
October 31, 2014	Email to Tim Tenhave with some info. Pre-filing maps show Northern Blvd in the area of Webb
November 10, 2014	Email from Tim Tenhave with info regarding the new path of the pipeline. Nothing about the new route of Tennessee Gas
November 17, 2014	Update to BOC under "Old Business" - letter in support for Hollis Conservation
November 25, 2014	Invitation to gas pipeline meeting from Eileen Cabanel (later cancelled)
December 9, 2014	Email from Rosemarie Rung with questions
December 10, 2014	Communication with Jeff Marts (EGGI) about new route of pipeline
December 12, 2014	Formally notified by Tennessee Gas of the new route
December 15, 2014	BOC meeting to discuss the Tennessee Gas Pipeline project
January 9, 2015	Brandon Kernen of DES states he is not in a position to write a letter opposing the pipeline but will work with MVD to ensure best management practices are followed.
January 20, 2015	Meeting with Patty Quinn, Senior Right-of-Way Agent from Kinder Morgan
January 22, 2015	Received key point of opposition of the pipeline from EGGI
January 26, 2015	BOC meeting - discussion and input from Horseshoe Fish and Game. MVD to generate letter to NH Site Evaluation Committee regarding opposition and points of concern.
January 28, 2015	MVD receives email from T. Tenhave with letter attached from Tennessee Gas to FERC opposing extension of open houses (public info and comment sessions)
January 28, 2015	Email from R. Miner to T. Tenhave giving approval for the Conservation Commission to survey MVD property where gas line is proposed through Gilmore Hill Memorial Forest
