Minimum Qualifications: High School Diploma or GED. Associates Degree in Fire Science or related field is preferred. Fire Inspector I Certification, NH State Firefighter Level I / II Certification, considerable experience in fire inspection work; experience with NFPA 1 (Uniform Fire Code) and NFPA 101 (Life Safety Code) including referenced NFPA Code within these documents is required, EMT Certification preferred or past EMS experience, or any equivalent combination of education, experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.
