TOWN CENTER COMMITTEE MINUTES JULY 1, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 12:05.

Old Business: Status of TAP award: Our TAP award was approved by the Governor's Council; it went to the Department of Transportation which was authorized to proceed with the project. DOT notified our Department of Public Works, and Rick Seymour issued an RFQ (Request for Quotes) to contractors who will design the project. Peter asked if we have any input into the project. Nelson agrees with that wish and will contact Kyle Fox to request it. Jackie said that the requirements of the State and Federal governments will rule the project, but Peter hopes that we can keep the design simple.

<u>Art in the Park:</u> The event has most approvals in place; the Town Council will discuss it next week. The Manchester Artists Association will oversee all the funding, invitations and marketing.

<u>Business Expo:</u> We will set up our poster there on September 18. We'll have some new brochures to distribute that were done by the Heritage Commission showing old houses within the Town Center.
