- National Drug Take Back day is this Saturday, April 29th. If you need to discard any of your old medications, please take advantage of our drug box in the main lobby from 10 AM to 2 PM.
- The Town of Merrimack, Parks & Recreation Department and the Friends of the Merrimack Dog Park cordially invite you to join us on Saturday, May 6th at 11:00 am to officially celebrate the opening of the new Dog Park at Wasserman Park with a ribbon cutting ceremony. With the warmer weather here, we wanted to invite the community out for an official grand opening ceremony. May 6th was chosen to coincide with PetSafe's National Dog Park Day, which is held on the first Saturday in May each year. The rain date for the event is May 13th.
- We have a few remaining compost bins and rain barrels available at the Transfer Station – first come, first serve. The compost bins are \$50 and the rain barrels are \$65.
