(RSA 669:6, 669:19) Candidates for Town Council must also have been domiciled in Merrimack for at least one year. (Town Charter Article 3-4, C)
- 2024 dog licenses are now available at the Town Clerk's office. Per NH State law, all owners of dogs four months and older are required to license their dog by May 1st. Owners must present a valid rabies certificate and a neutering or spaying certificate, if applicable. If you no longer have your dog, please contact the Town Clerk's office at 424-3651 so that we may update our records.
