Part of discussion was also around ensuring ATV/Bikes follow the rules as recently one of the gates off of Grater Road was damaged. - Access issues / unauthorized trail use Trail that had been closed across from view appears to being accessed again via motor bikes. Need assistance in getting this access/use stopped. Joe will review if signs /trail closures can be performed to keep riders out.
- Kiosk refresh –new map, review examples School Kiosk will be updated with Grater Woods trail map. (Larger Size). Will also include the 2017 hunting information sheet.

Will need to update the Beebe Lane, Conservation drive, Classroom and School Kiosk. Also discussed added a sign near the school soccer field / Gateway trail entrance.

- Outdoor Classroom benches -- Steve to check with Scouts if an Eagle Scout project could address the classroom.
- Bambi Lane bridge / boardwalk work dates Current "trail" is covered in flowing water so a re-route and boardwalk are needed. Need to pick dates to measure and create a plan. (Initial review Saturday (4/22-- meet at Bambi Cul de sac). Potential date Sunday 4/30).
