## WHEN

- BEFORE AND AFTER DIRECT CONTACT WITH A PATIENT
- AFTER GLOVE REMOVAL
- AFTER CONTACT

   VICINITY OF A
   PATIENT
- AFTER USING THE RESTROOM
- AFTER SNEEZING,
   BLOWING YOUR
   NOSE, OR TOUCHING
   YOUR FACE OR HAIR

- USE SOAP AND
  WARM WATER IF
  HANDS ARE VISIBLY
  SOILED
- → RUB HANDS TOGETHER VIGOROUSLY FOR AT LEAST 15 SECONDS
- → RINSE UNDER RUNNING WATER AND PAT DRY
- → TURN WATER OFF WITH TOWEL
- IF HANDS AREN'T VISIBLY SOILED, YOU CAN USE ALCOHOL-BASED HAND RUB
- → APPLY TO PALM OF ONE HAND AND RUB HANDS TOGETHER TO COVER ALL SURFACES
- → RUB UNTIL HANDS ARE DRY
