 Two (2) sets of plans (highlighted alarm components) and submittal / specification book and fire alarm (specific devices used highlighted), Scope of Work, Battery load calculations, Single line diagram, Legend of Symbols, UL Certificate of Compliance for Central Station Alarm Company will be required (Reference Fire Alarm Plan Conditions Document). Permit fees shall be paid in full at time of submittal. The Contact person will be notified upon completion of plan review. All plans and work MUST comply with NFPA 1, NFPA 101, NFPA 72, NFPA 13, all State of New Hampshire, the Town of Merrimack, and Office of the Fire Marshal rules and regulations and manufacturers installation instructions. Work on any job, requiring a permit, prior to the issuance of a permit will result in a stop-work order and fine that must be paid prior to the releasing of a permit, or prior to any inspections being performed. A COPY OF THE APPROVED PRINT SHALL BE KEPT ON SITE AND PRESENTED TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT UPON REQUEST. FAILURE TO HAVE THE, APPROVED PLANS AND THE PLAN REVIEW SUMMARY FROM THE OFFICE OF THE FIRE MARSHAL WILL CONSTITUTE WORKING WITHOUT A PERMIT.
