**REPORTS FOR NOVEMBER 2014** 

The following is an overview of the activities performed by Equipment Maintenance and Highway Divisions in the Merrimack Public Works Department in November 2014:

## **Equipment Maintenance Division**


- Completed 52 corrective maintenance repair orders and road service calls on Town vehicles, including:
  - o Replaced suspension spring for Highway loader H-16
  - o Replaced plow pump/motor for Highway 1-ton dump truck H-7
- Performed 62 preventive maintenance repair orders
- Issued 8 repair orders to outside entities, including:
  - o Rotated and replaced tires for Solid Waste trailer
  - Repaired power issue with Fire Department ambulance A-3
  - Replaced tires for Highway dump truck H-33

## **Equipment Maintenance Division, cont.**


• Managed \$16,120 in equipment maintenance town-wide





## **Highway and Parks Maintenance Division**

- Received or managed 71 work orders and service requests
  - Closed 49 work orders
    - 88% were open for less than 30 days
  - 0% of pothole requests were closed less than 72 hours from first report



- Responded to 3 winter storm events:

  - 18<sup>th</sup> (treated roads) 26<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> (24 hour plow and downed tree & line event into Thanksgiving)
  - 28<sup>th</sup> (treated roads)
  - Total material distributed:
    - 12 truckloads of salt
    - 21.5 truckloads of sand/salt mix
- Moved portable light towers from Wasserman Park football field to highway yard for winter storage
- Removed football goal posts from Veterans Park
- Shut down tennis courts at Wasserman Park
- Performed setup and restoration from general elections



December 16, 2014

- Completed pre-season preparations of winter maintenance equipment
- Completed drainage improvements at Glenforest Drive and South Baboosic Lake Road
- Placed gravel shoulder support in newly paved areas
- Continued fall cleanups of parks and cemeteries
- Performed water shutoff at Wasserman Park and town fields
- Constructed ice rink at O'Gara Drive and secured winter volunteer corps
- Assisted Conservation Commission with town wide beaver management plan
- Assisted with safety and coordination of Turkey Trot road race after Thanksgiving snow storm
- Completed seasonal gravel road maintenance
- Held first weigh-in of the Badges vs. Hardhats Holiday Food Drive:
  - $\circ$  PD = 1,129 lbs
  - Public Works = 305 lbs
- Attended training
  - o NH DES: Underground storage tank operator certification
