

Operator I – Wastewater Division

The **Town of Merrimack** is accepting applications for the full-time position of **Operator I** for the **Department of Public Works** – **Wastewater Division**. This is skilled work in the operation of a sewage treatment plant or pumping stations on an assigned shift. Work involves responsibility for the operation of pumps, air compressors, chlorinators, and other appurtenances at a treatment plant or pumping stations. The employee of this class must exercise judgment in making adjustments to machinery and equipment, and related control apparatus in accordance with established operating procedures and standards. Candidates must have a high school diploma or equivalent and the ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions, accurately follow operating and recording procedures, and detect faulty operation characteristics in equipment or processes and institute remedial action. State of New Hampshire Certification requires minimum of Operator I.

Starting wage is \$18.88 – 19.91/hr. plus a great benefits package. Movement on wage scale based on steps for time in grade. Normal hours are Sunday through Thursday from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm (subject to change). Health, life, and short-term disability insurance premiums are currently 100% employer paid. Includes paid vacation, sick, & personal leave, and participation in the New Hampshire Retirement System.
