MAINTAINER I - PT

NATURE OF WORK:

The employee in this position performs unskilled and semi-skilled labor in the maintenance of wastewater facility building and grounds to include pump stations.

Work involves responsibility for the safe and efficient operation of tools, including power tools and light duty motor vehicles used in the maintenance of wastewater facility. Work assignments are normally received from a Chief Operator or other manager, and after instructions have been given, work is generally performed with limited additional supervision. Work is reviewed by a supervisor for conformance with instructions and for the safety and care exercised in operating tools and vehicles.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the general supervision of the Chief Operator. May receive additional direction and instruction from other employees within the Wastewater Division at the direction of the Chief Operator or Maintenance Manager

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK: The list below is intended to be illustrative and employees in this class may not perform all the duties listed include nor does this list contain all of the duties required of employees in this position

- Operates light trucks not requiring a CDL license to move personnel and equipment between work sites
- Operates hand and power tools such as rakes, shovels, trimmers, blowers and mowers used in the maintenance of wastewater facility and pump station grounds. Performs minor maintenance such as checking fluid levels and filters. Reports need for repairs to Chief Operator or Maintenance Manager
- Provides custodial work such as cleaning of restrooms, sweeping and mopping of floors, and keeps facilities supplied with soap and paper products. May make minor repairs

- Mows lawns, uses string trimmers and hedge clippers
- Shovels walkways and stairs, spreads sand and salt on walkways and stairs, uses snow blowers as assigned
- Performs related work as required.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS:

Must be physically able to perform manual labor in an indoor and outdoor environment in any weather condition. Must be able to follow verbal instructions and work with limited supervision. Must have a valid NH drivers license.

High school education or GED

Talking: Necessary for communicating with others.

Hearing: Necessary for taking instructions and receiving information.

Sight: Necessary for doing job effectively and correctly.
