The Group assembled in the Nashua Corp's offices at 10:00 a.m.

The walk started at Nashua Corp, where Ms. Beard explained the needs and concerns of Nashua Corp.

The group then walked to the southern part of the lower site, where Mr. Woods, Mr. Lavoie and Mr. Hughes indicated the needs of the remaining tenants (Webb's and UHL) and their longer term plans should they be able to fill the site.

The Group then moved onto the proposed development. The Applicants and their engineer used their drawings to show the walkers the salient points of the project. There were no markers to guide people, but it was possible to determine the approximate layout.

Mr. Woods, Mr. Lavoie, and Mr. Hughes, together with Mr. Bangert indicated the concerns and requirements of Nanocomp. They made particular reference to use of the southern entrance, the existing one way traffic system and the need to keep non-employees off their site, in view of the nature of the work and the chemicals in use.

It was very apparent during the site walk that the aroma from the Merrimack Waste Water treatment plant is going to be a significant issue under some weather conditions.

In view of the proximity of the northernmost accommodation unit to the PRMG site, Chairman Best asked the applicants to consider extending some of the other units in order to maintain the number of units, yet permit a greater separation.

The walk concluded at approximately 11:30 a.m. There was not a quorum of Planning Board Members present.
