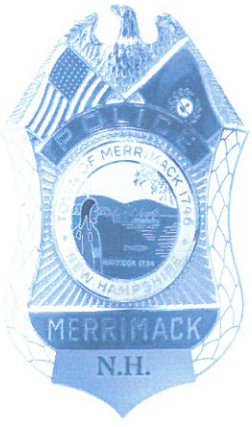

RE: DONATION FROM CRIMELINE

The Merrimack Police Department respectfully requests that this Honorable Board accept a donation in the amount of \$4110.00 from Crimeline to be deposited into the Police K-9 account, AKA the "Dallas" account.

A check in the amount of \$4110.00 was presented to Chief Roy in December of 2017. Crimeline has annually raised monies for the K-9 program for purposes of upkeep and maintenance. The majority of these monies are raised from their annual fundraisers. To date well over \$24,000 has been donated from Crimeline to the police department, which helps covers expenses such as, insurance, equipment, Veterinary Bills, and the future purchase of a new canine.
