On April 4th, 2018 the Merrimack Police department held their 23rd annual Citizen Academy graduation. This year approximately 20 residents from the Town of Merrimack took part in learning more about their police department and met weekly from the end of January to the beginning of April. The class was educated in many areas in what the police officers and their support staff do on a daily basis. Classes ranged from recruiting, patrol functions, dispatch to defensive tactics, firearms and drug investigations. Class were taught by members of the department and few outside agencies (partners)

The police department takes pride in presenting this class and it is one of the most effective community service programs we offer. These classes along with the others in the past appreciate the efforts of the department and deeply enjoy attending.

This year the 23rd Citizen's Academy presented at the graduation a check written in the amount of \$500 as a gift. The class represented to the staff that the gift was not intended for anything specific and left it up to the discretion of the department.

As in the past the department looks for a suggestion that the class can take pride in, and a way that the class can be remembered for the years to come. At this time the department is looking into steaming a "low profile" blue light that will illuminate the outside of the building; similar to the blue light that you see at night on the Holiday Inn. The blue light would be lit in good taste and allow the members of the 23rd class to drive-by and to see where their gift was spent.
