On March 9-10<sup>th</sup> The St. John Neumann Youth Ministry participated in the St. John's Fast for Social Action. The Ministry raised funds to benefit local non-profit agencies that help those in need. The Ministry would like to donate \$2,250 to the Merrimack Police PACT Program because of difference the program makes in the lives of children in our community.

The Police Department is respectfully requesting that the Council accept this donation on behalf of the Town and Department and allow the expenditure of the monies to go to the PACT Program. "PACT", Police and Children Together program has been a collaborative effort between the Police Department and the Merrimack School District since 2009. Its main purpose is to teach our children to make good decisions while avoiding those that are destructive.

Monies will be used to offset the expenses to purchase educational materials for the classroom along with promotional gifts that are given to the students, such as; honorary badges, hats and stickers.
