Hi Eileen,

On Wednesday, March 21st; Boy Scout Anthony Milani from Troop 272 in Nashua made a presentation to the Parks & Recreation Committee on his Eagle Scout Project that he would like to complete with the Town of Merrimack.

For his project, Anthony is proposing to build an information kiosk at the entrance to the Quarry Trail at Wasserman Park, which will be used as a central location for posting trail information by the Conservation Commission on their network of trails in Wasserman Park.

Last August, Matt Caron from the Conservation Commission came before the Parks & Recreation Committee as they were looking to have a kiosk built. Since the Wasserman Conservation Land begins at the edge of the parking lot at Wasserman Park; the sign would officially be on land under Parks & Recreation's jurisdiction. Matt Caron connected us with Anthony to get this project done.

The Parks & Recreation Committee feels that his project would be a valuable addition and are recommending it to the Town Council for approval.
