SUBJECT: Girl Scout Project Proposal

Hi Eileen,

On Wednesday, November 28th; members of Girl Scout Troop 10762 presented a project proposal to the Parks & Recreation Committee. They would like to build an install an outdoor hopscotch court and would like to place it at Watson Park. They chose Watson Park over any other location because wanted to provide an additional passive recreation opportunity for people to do within the park. The hopscotch court would be made out of painted patio paver stones which would be embedded and inch or two into the ground so that it wasn't a tripping hazard.

They are flexible in the location within Watson Park but in talking with the Parks & Recreation Committee was utilizing a flat area directly behind the Gazebo.

The Parks & Recreation Committee feels that his project would be a valuable addition to Watson Park and are recommending it to the Town Council for approval.
