On January 7, 2019, a petition to place a warrant article on the 2019 Town Warrant and ballot was filed with the Town Manager's office and forwarded to the Town Clerk's office for verification.

According to Town Charter, section 10-1,B, petitions must be signed by at least 50 registered voters. Although the signature verification process is not defined in Article 10-1, section B, the method used was that as defined under Article 10-2, section A. This section states that "within seven (7) days after the filing of an initiative petition, the Town Clerk shall ascertain by what number of registered voters the petition is signed, and shall attach thereto a certificate showing the result of such examination".

Due to staffing issues in the Town Clerk's office, the Supervisors of the Checklist examined the list signatures submitted and compared the same against the current voter checklist. I am just now getting this report to you.

124 signatures were submitted with the petition. One was determined to be a duplicate. Of the remaining 123 signatures, 73 have been verified, and 50 have been rejected as they are un-registered voters.

It has been determined that the petition meets the 50 signature requirement under the Group Petition Process of section 10-1, B. of the Town Charter. The petition is attached and is being returned to you.
