


It has come to my attention that Merrimack, New Hampshire includes the assessed value of solar panels and arrays in the property taxes. This is contrary to the 135 other towns and cities (or 234) in New Hampshire that either completely exempt taxing solar panels or provide some kind of exemption in their property assessment.

It is my belief that solar and other renewable energy is the wave of the future. It needs to be encouraged rather than hampered with extra taxation. I know of more than one person that does not want to install solar panels solely because they do not want to be taxed for it. Some of my acquaintances would argue that taxing solar panels is on par with taxing a heating oil tank or an electric panel.

Regardless, I firmly believe that renewable energy should be nurtured and promoted in a positive light. We need to look towards the future and not just for financing the next fiscal year. By exempting solar panels from taxation we are encouraging their use and other renewable energy sources. We are prioritizing them for our future and saying we care about the environment and the health of our children.

As a resident of Merrimack, NH, I take pride in my town. I hope that Merrimack will move towards a greater leadership role in environmental health, not just in terms of cleaning up our water. In 3 short days, talking to just a tiny fraction of Merrimack residents, I was able to gather over 50 signatures.
