RE: Station 3 (Reeds Ferry Station)



As many of you know, the Reeds Ferry Station (Station 3) is located by the new Flatley development. With the construction of the new apartments, it appears we have a critter problem that is affecting the Town's equipment. These little critters have ruined some hose and one SCBA mask as well as some other equipment. We have received a quote for securing the building against these little critters. The contractor will be sealing the entire perimeter of the siding to the foundation as well as sealing all door weather stripping with rodent guard. They will also be sealing all fascia board and sealing up all existing holes.

I have attached a list of equipment that has been ruined as well as a list of equipment stored at the Station.

I will be seeking reimbursement from Primex, the Town's insurance provider, for the replacement equipment. Whatever Primex doesn't pay for will be funded through the Fire Department's budget. The total cost to complete the work is about \$16,000.
