SUBJECT: Eagle Scout Candidate Project Proposal

Hi Eileen.

On Wednesday, May 15th; Boy Scout Max Townsend from Troop 48 made a presentation to the Parks & Recreation Committee on his proposed Eagle Scout Project that he would like to complete with the Parks & Recreation Department.

For his project, he has separate components that he is looking to complete. For the first part of his project he is proposing to repair our existing wall ball court. The wall ball court is next to the Tennis Courts and allows someone to practice tennis by themselves. The current wall gets a lot of use but is rotten and falling apart. In this same area; we have discovered that the court for wall ball also meets the dimensions for a Pickleball court. Pickleball is one of the fastest growing sports in the country particularly with the senior population. It combines the elements of badminton, tennis and table tennis. So he will mark out the lines of the court and also provide us a portable pickleball net on wheels so that people can use the court area for wall ball or for the pickleball. Lastly, over near the playground at Wasserman Park, he is proposing to build and install a split rail fence for the safety of younger children at the park. It's about 25 feet from the back of the playground to the woods and shortly after those trees begin, the land slopes downwards at a fairly steep grade. The fence would prevent younger children from accidentally going over the edge.

The Parks & Recreation Committee feels that his project would be a valuable addition and are recommending it to the Town Council for approval.
