The agenda request before the Town Council is to accept a donation of \$924 from the Merrimack Rotary Club to purchase 12 lithium polymer batteries (\$77 each) for our secondary portable radios. These radios are distributed to various town buildings as a means to communicate in case of an emergency. The portables are also utilized by our volunteers when they are assisting the police department. The portables are stored in a recharging bank in our dispatch center and can be easily deployed during a critical incident. The batteries that we currently utilize are not effectively charging and fail to hold a charge making the portable radio inoperable. The old batteries would be discarded in the proper manner and would be replaced as soon as the new batteries arrive.
