## Short History

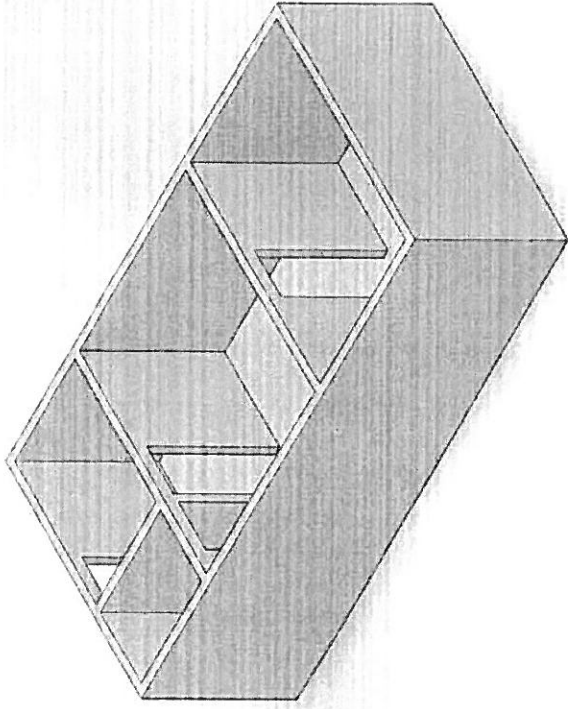
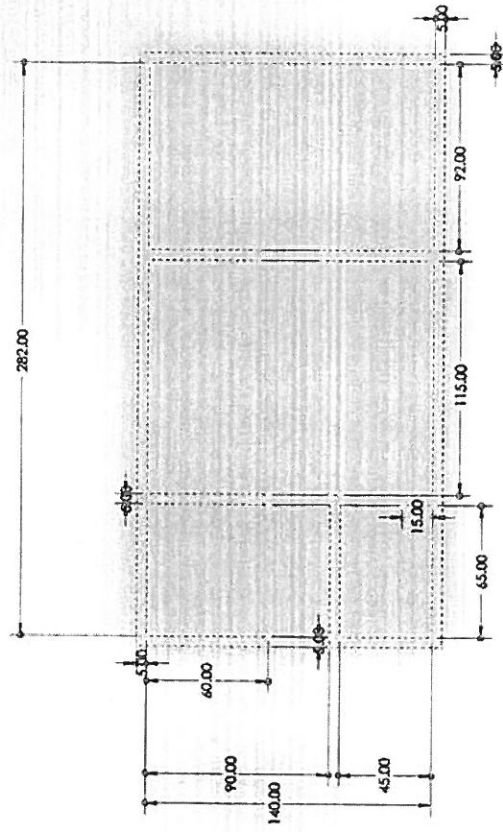
- The original use of the cabin was to be a “living place” for the lifeguards
- It stopped getting used and became a place to store things that didn't have anywhere else to go
- The shed hasn't been used in quite a few years

## Proposed Project

- The cabin is located very close to the primary waterfront of Wasserman Park
- We will be tearing out a wall and adding 7 changing stalls, two of which are large enough for either families or handicap members of the camp
- The bathroom will be renovated, adding a new toilet, sink, and a vinyl tiled floor.
- New lights bright enough to light up the whole space
- Walls on the inside will be painted
- Railings will be added to the exterior stairs to ensure safety

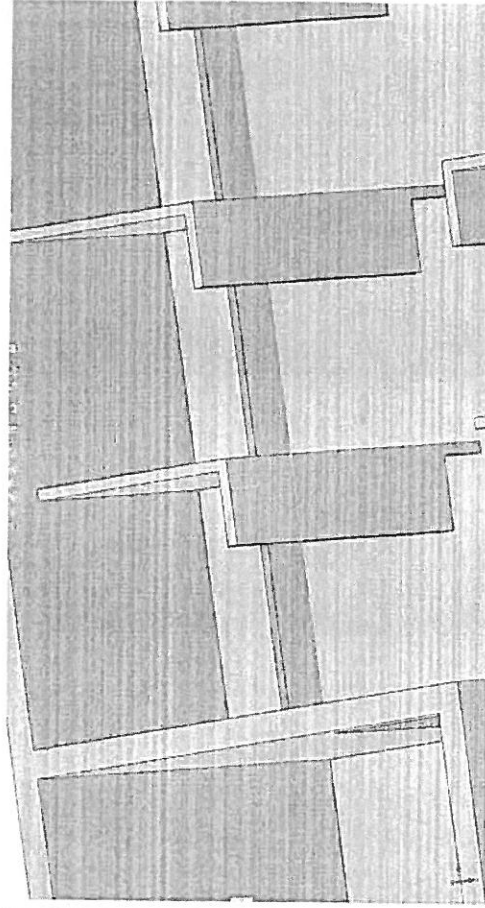
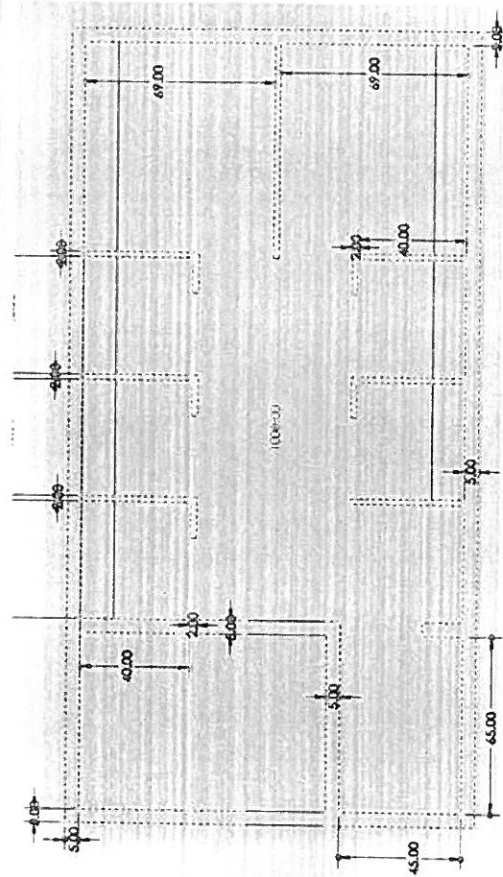
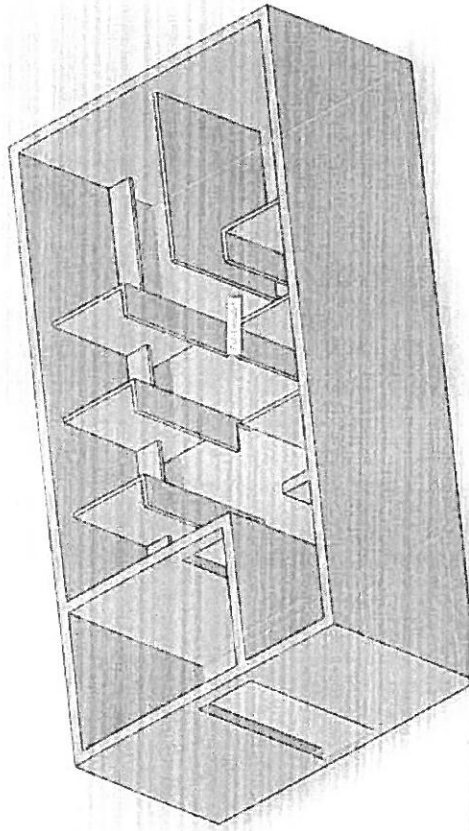
