The Rotary Club of Merrimack has approached us and is interested in repainting the interior of the Function Hall at Wasserman Park for the Parks & Recreation Department.

This is a project we have been interested in completing for a few years now but never had the resources to do so on our own before. With the other improvements we have made to the Function Hall in recent years; painting the interior of the building will help freshen up the space from an old "campy" building to one that is more modern. This in turn will help us market the building and bring in new rentals of the facility.

The Rotary Club would be purchasing all of the paint and painting supplies and their club members would be the ones doing the painting. There will be no cost to the Town of Merrimack.

We feel that this will be a wonderful improvement to the Function Hall. We are estimating they will need 15 Gallons of Paint and with materials; it should cost them approximately \$500.00 for those materials.
