AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 183 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

The Town of Merrimack ordains the following:

Chapter 183 is amended by adding the following new Section 183-23:

Chapter 183 Vehicles and Traffic			
Article III. Parking Restrictions			
[§183-23 No Parking Areas.			
 A. The following areas are designated as no parking zones, to include the entire width of the travel lanes and road shoulders: (1) Currier Road (2) Souhegan Drive (3) Birch Street (4) Tiffany Lane (5) Pinehaven Drive (6) Fir Street]

AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 183 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

The Town of Merrimack ordains the following:

Chapter 183 is amended by adding the following new Section 183-23:

Chapter 183 Vehicles and Traffic			
Article III. Parking Restrictions			
[§183-23 Temporary Parking Regulations.			
A. The Town Council and/or Police Chief may issue temporary parking bans under exigent, special, or extraordinary circumstances, or during special events. It shall be a violation of these regulations to stop or park a motor vehicle in a manner that is contrary to the official posted signs indicating a temporary parking ban is in effect.]			
This shall become effective upon passage.
