We are requesting to utilize the Abbie Griffin Memorial Fund for several different purchases that we have not budgeted for. First, we would like to upgrade our technology in our training/community room. Currently, we have an old computer that cannot support many videos due to a poor graphic card. We also are utilizing an old cd/cassette home stereo system as an audio output for the computer. This room is used for training and is utilized by many civic groups in town. We would like to make this room more professional by purchasing the appropriate electronics to support adequate training and community events. We plan to purchase a new computer, speakers, HD projector, computer stand, and a video conference camera. The video conference camera will allow us to attend trainings and meeting remotely which is critical in these times. The total cost of the above items is \$3,280.

We would also like to purchase two FLIR ONE Pro thermal cameras for smartphones. These thermal cameras attach to a smart phone allowing it to become a thermal imager that can be used for search and rescue or tracking wanted subjects. We will purchase one for use with iOS and one for Androids. They cost \$399.99 each for a total of \$799.98. These light weight cameras are compact and can be deployed quickly. We would also like to purchase two Viper HD binoculars. These binoculars would be utilized for search and rescue. Our Special Response Team would utilize them to gather intelligence from a safe distance when they are activated. Each binocular costs \$445 for a total of \$890. The total cost for the FLIR cameras and binoculars is \$1,689.98.

We would also like to purchase a hard rubber body opponent bag called a Century BOB.

This is a rubber torso on a stand that we would use to practice firing our 40 mm launcher at. We could also utilize it for hand or foot strikes during defensive tactics training. The cost of the unit is \$425. We would also like to purchase steel targets for our firing range. Steel targets are a great tool for training because officers can hear when they have a direct strike. Currently, we use paper targets with a cardboard target behind the paper. Steel targets would save on purchasing paper and cardboard targets. We would like to purchase 6 pistol steel target systems at \$210.94 each for a total of \$1,265.64 and 4 rifle steel target systems for \$366.57 each for a total of \$1,466.28. The total cost for the Century BOB body bag and the steel target systems is \$3,156.92
