DONATED "SPIDER NET GUN" PACKAGE

The purpose of this memorandum is to officially request the scheduling of an agenda item regarding a donated "Spider" brand net gun package to be used by the Department's Animal Control Officer (ACO). Merrimack resident Dean King has purchased the net gun, valued at \$587.00, for use by the Department's ACO to assist in capturing loose or sick animals.

Net guns have been safely used by Zookeepers, Farmers and Law Enforcement to assist in animal control and rescue situations. The CO2 powered net gun looks like a large flashlight and can fire a net approximately 45 feet, although it works best at a distance of 25-30 feet. As there are many times we're called to assist with a sick or loose animal, having this tool will greatly assist our ACO in safely securing these animals.

I have also provided a net gun manual for your review, which explains in more detail the benefits of this tool and how it operates. I would appreciate the opportunity to present this donation to you for your consideration at your earliest convenience.
