The Public Works Department, as part of the 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) preparations, recommended the replacement of two 2005 Spectec Steel Open Top Live Floor Trailers for the Solid Waste Division. The replacement was listed in the CIP at an estimated cost of \$70,000 per trailer; one in fiscal year 2020/2021 and another in 2021/2022. The replacement the first trailer was placed in the 2020/21 Capital Improvement Program and the second in the 2021/2022 Capital Improvement Program, both approved by the Town Council in their respective years. Being in consecutive fiscal years, the Department put the two trailers out to bid in an effort to improve pricing due to economies of scale.

Bids for the new trailers were received by the Finance Department on June 4th – the results of the bids are shown in the following table:

Following a review of the bids, the Department is recommending the purchase of the two Steel Open Top Live Floor Trailers from Spector Manufacturing Inc. We currently have a fleet of all Spectec trailers, three live floor (2005, 2005, 2019) and one dump trailer (2020), and have been satisfied with their performance and the service provided by Spector Manufacturing. Many of the benefits of switching to aluminum trailers do not apply to our application. Commercial haulers

use aluminum trailers because of the lighter weight which allows them to haul a greater tonnage. Though we load every trailer to its full capacity and try to maximize the tonnage of every trailer we haul, it is not the driving force behind our operation as we do not reach legal weight limits fully loaded. Providing quality, efficient service to the residents of Merrimack is our priority. The only advantages that the department considered in switching to aluminum trailers was the possibility of extending the useful life of the trailer, reduced maintenance, and the trade-in allowance at the end of their useful life. However, once you consider the increased cost and lesser warranty, we believe the Spectec trailers will better suit our needs. We propose utilizing the Trade-in of our two 2005 Spectec Steel Open Top Live Floor Trailers to partially offset the purchase price of the two new trailers at a total request of \$159,994.00. The Solid Waste Disposal Capital Reserve Fund currently has a balance of \$446,000 as of 05/31/2021.
