American Rescue Plan Act 2021



The use of American Rescue Plan Act Funds (ARPA) is prescribed in the Treasury Department's guidelines (below), ARPA Funds have to be spent by 2024. The Town will receive two payments of \$1,386,614 for a total of \$2,773,229. While reviewing the guidelines set forth I have come up with a potential list of what the Town can spend the ARPA Funds on:

- 1. Screenings Building WWTF
- 2. Revenue shortfalls (at this time however it appears that overall the net revenue of the Town for fiscal year 2020-21 is a positive so these funds cannot be used.)
- 3. Stormwater Drainage projects

## USE OF LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS

According to the U.S. Treasury, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds provide eligible local governments with a substantial infusion of resources to meet pandemic response needs and rebuild a stronger, and more equitable economy as the country recovers. Recipients may use these funds to:

- **Support public health expenditures**, by, for example, funding COVID-19 mitigation efforts, medical expenses, behavioral healthcare, and certain public health and safety staff
- Address negative economic impacts caused by the public health emergency, including economic harms to
  workers, households, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector
- Replace lost public sector revenue, using this funding to provide government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue experienced due to the pandemic
- **Provide premium pay for essential workers**, offering additional support to those who have and will bear the greatest health risks because of their service in critical infrastructure sectors
- Invest in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure, making necessary investments to improve access to clean drinking water, support vital wastewater and stormwater infrastructure, and to expand access to broadband internet

Within these overall categories, recipients have broad flexibility to decide how best to use this funding to meet the needs of their communities.
