Public Hearing

Residents of Merrimack are hereby advised that the Town Council will hold a public hearing to receive public input on a proposed issuance of debt as follows, "Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,500,000 for a New Fire Ladder Truck, and expenses related to the issuance of municipal bonds; to finance said sum by the issuance of bonds or serial notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000, thereby reduced by any federal, state, or private grants that may be made available in conjunction with said purpose; to authorize the Town Council to apply for and accept said grants of federal, state, or private aid; to authorize the Town Council to issue, negotiate, sell, and deliver said bonds and notes and to determine the rate of interest, the maturity, and other terms pertaining thereto; and to authorize the Town Council to take any other action or to pass any other measure relative to said purpose and financing; and to further raise and appropriate the sum of \$15,000 for the purpose of 2022-23 interest on said bonds or serial notes?"

All interested parties are invited to attend. The public hearing will be held on **Thursday**, **February 10**, **2022 at 7:00 PM** in the Matthew Thornton Room located at 8 Baboosic Lake Road in Merrimack.
