





**LEGAL NOTICE**

**Public Hearing**

Residents of Merrimack are hereby advised that the Town Council will hold a public hearing to receive public input on a proposed issuance of debt as follows “Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,102,750 (gross budget) for Waste Water Treatment upgrades to the Wash Water Piping, Compost Facility, Headworks Building and New Screening Building as well as ADA improvements and other miscellaneous upgrades to the main plant, and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$10,102,750 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the Town Council to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon; and to further authorize the Town Council to apply for, obtain and accept any federal, state, or other aid, grants or other funds, that may be made available in conjunction with said purpose that may reduce the amount to be financed with bonds and notes, and to participate in the State Revolving Fund (SRF) RSA 486:14 established for this purpose; and to allow the Town Council to take any other action or to pass any other vote relative thereto?”

All interested parties are invited to attend. The public hearing will be held on **Thursday, February 10, 2022 at 7:00 PM** in the Matthew Thornton Room located at 8 Baboosic Lake Road in Merrimack.
