The Acton Children's Business Fair inspires children to discover their inner entrepreneur. the largest entrepreneurship event for kids in North America, this one-day market gives children the opportunity to show case the opportunity to showcase their very own business.

Jeff and Laura Sandefer and a few other families wanted to spark a sense of wonder and entrepreneurship in their children, so they created the 1<sup>st</sup> Acton Children's Business Fair in Austin, Texas, in 2007. That year, there were 7 entrepreneurs and around 25 attendees. Now, there are over 115 entrepreneurs and 1,500 attendees at the Acton Children's Business Fair in Austin.

- The fair will be a tented outdoor event with booths
- Each business will be given a booth with an 8-foot table, full tent covering, and 1-2 chairs
- Booths are not likely to have electricity
- Designed to give children the experience of selling a product or service
- The child running the booth are responsible for set up, customer interaction, and sales
