Gentlemen,

Here is what I have. I know Matt is out until next week so no worries; I wanted to send what I have.

The first attachment is the flyer that will go around the school. I just need see if we can settle on what night this will be held, start/end dates, etc. I know you are looking for 12-15 students and I know of 4 that have been asking for something like this; I think we can get to 12-15 very quickly. The QR Code brings you to my "Upcoming ELO's page" which is found here: https://sites.google.com/sau26.org/extendedlearningopportunities/upcoming-elos. You will see a place holder for the Teen Academy and I am working on the page...it's not yet ready for prime time but you can at least see where the link goes.

The second attachment is the permission slip I created specifically for the Teen Academy. It would go home with the other ELO forms that students/parents need to complete. I used the language from my Criminology Syllabus to help here. I also think we could limit it to 10-12th grade if your lawyers are concerned about ages. We limit the Crim class to 10-12 so that would mirror our school policy. I don't think that would cut down on our numbers; I think it would help in future years to lay the groundwork for more classes. If lawyers on your side need to tweak it, I have zero heartburn with it. My obligation to inform parents seems to well below the threshold your lawyers are asking for, so I can work around what comes from them.

Lastly, I would also like to see if we can have an Informational meeting so that students (and parents) can sign up to get more information and ask questions. After the meeting, I could ask students to sign up via a Google form. I am tentatively looking at something the week of Nov. 13 or the week of Nov. 27 (one night only, 6-7 PM) here at MHS so we can use the Theater. I am not sure how you would like to handle it but I would love to have one of you here for the meeting.

That is what I have now. Let me know what else you need from me.
