Re: Merrimack Charter Amendment

Dear Clerk Trippett:

Pursuant to RSA 49-B:4-a, on behalf of the Town of Merrimack, you submitted a charter amendment for review, dated December 14, 2023.

Upon review, the New Hampshire Attorney General's Office, the Secretary of State's Office, and the Department of Revenue Administration, pursuant to RSA 49-B:4-a, **do not object** to the proposed amendment to the town charter.

Please note that this non-objection is explicitly conditioned on the student representative being a non-voting member and not counting towards a quorum as is made clear in the documentation forwarded to our offices. Under RSA 36-A:3, a conservation commission may have no fewer than three members and no more than seven. That same statute is silent on having any representatives that do not vote and do not count towards a quorum. Therefore, the amendment as proposed is not violative of RSA 36-A:3. However, if the student representative had the traditional rights and powers of other council members under RSA 36-A, that representative would constitute an eighth member of the council and, therefore, would be violative of the statue.
