The parcel is located at 143 Baboosic Lake Road in the R-1 (Residential, by soils), and Aquifer Conservation Districts. <u>Tax Map 5C, Lot 082-04</u>. Case #2019-28.

Chestnut Hill Properties, LLC (petitioner/owner) <u>Variance under Section 3.08.8 of the Zoning Ordinance to allow previously approved cluster subdivision lots (permitted by previous variance to be allowed in the R-1 District) to be serviced by individual septic systems whereas municipal sewer is required. The parcels are located at Bannon Circle and Ritterbush Court (approved, not constructed roads) in the R-1 (Residential, by map) District. <u>Tax</u> Map 5B, Lots 002, 005, 007, 008, 009-01 through 009-71. Case #2019-29.</u>
