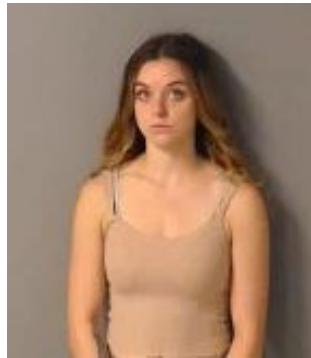

On July 20th, 2022 at approximately 9:11 AM an Officer from the Merrimack Police Department was dispatched to the area of Bedford Rd. and Joppa Rd. for a possible motor vehicle accident. Upon arrival in the

area there was no vehicle on scene. The officer observed fresh tire marks in the grass area which led to a snapped guy wire of an Eversource utility pole. Upon further investigation, a license plate was discovered in the area of the crash. The vehicle owner was identified as Kayla Antle out of Henniker, NH. With the assistance of Henniker PD it was determined that the vehicle owned by Antle had struck the guy wire and left the scene of an accident without reporting it.

The primary investigating Officer applied for and was granted a warrant for Antle's arrest. Antle turned herself in to the Merrimack Police Department on August 11th, 2022 where she was processed and charged accordingly. She was released on personal recognizance bail and is scheduled to be arraigned on August 25th, 2022 at 8:15 AM in the 9th Circuit District Court - Merrimack Division.
