## **FERC Scoping Meeting Tips**

- The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) put out a schedule of scoping meetings on the Kinder Morgan Northeast Energy Direct Pipeline ("Gas Pipeline") on June 30, 2015
  - Comments on the schedule and other issues in the June 30 notice are due to FERC by **August 31**, **2015**.
- FERC scheduled two scoping meetings near Merrimack

- A third scoping meeting is anticipated the week of July 27-31 in or around Winchester, NH
- Arrive at least an hour in advance of the meeting to sign up for a speaking slot
  - FERC will start the sign up sheets for speakers one hour in advance of the meeting (i.e. 5:30 pm). Heavy turnout is anticipated and lines may form before 5:30
- Have your comments in writing
  - FERC will accept written comments and will enter those comments into the record
- Meeting process
  - FERC staff will describe the process and then start on the list of speakers.
  - FERC will likely limit the amount of time each speaker may speak (likely just a minute or two)
  - ► FERC will continue through the list of speakers until the contracted for facility time is over
  - FERC will have a transcriptionist at the meeting and a transcript of the scoping meeting will be put in the FERC record
- Issues to discuss
  - ► Impact of route
  - ► Route alternatives?
  - ► Timeline and scope of FERC scoping meetings
    - FERC is holding scoping meetings requiring public comment on impacts from the proposed route and comparisons of those impacts with alternatives <u>before</u> KM submits its next draft of the resource reports which show the route impacts and compare impacts between alternatives. These resource report revisions are anticipated in the next month.
    - Additional time to comment on the next drafts or additional scoping meetings might assist many interested parties
